OCME Board Elections Soon

All eligible members of OCME will be receiving a ballot sometime in the month of November. You will be voting for those members who have volunteered to serve as your representative on the Club's Board of Directors. The ballot you will be receiving will look much different that those of past years.

Our By-Laws state, in part, "In order to establish a continuity, rotation is scheduled with two (2) directors to serve two (2) years and three (3) directors to server two (2) years. (one year different from the other two directors)." This ballot will be much different because of prior Board appointments. The reason is successors to any Board position, having been appointed by the current Board members, can fill that Board position until such time as a regular election is held so that person may fill out the unexpired term of the person who they succeeded on the Board.

Joe Hayes was appointed by the Board to fill in for Kevin Tolan, whose term of office will expire in December 2012.

Claire Marsden was appointed by the Board to fill in for Lori Tolan, whose term of office will expire in December 2012.

Dixon Sheldon was appointed by the Board to fill in for Mike Getscher, whose term of office will expire in December of 2011. **Dixon** will be running for a regular two (2) year term starting January 2012.

Larry Ogle was elected to a two (2) year term that started in January 2010 and is running for a second two (2) year term.

Myron Peterson was elected to his second consecutive two (2) year term that started in January 2010 and must relinquish his seat on the Board because the maximum term for any director is four years (two consecutive term). You will not see his name on the ballot, but you will see a another member who will be running for a position on our Board.
