

Public Ride Day - Train Crew Safety

The Safety Meeting, held prior to the start of each Public Ride Day, is vitally important to all engineers and conductors. Kenny Matessa, our Station Master, does a great job doing this.

The following two safety procedures have been implemented:

1. Late arrivals who miss the Safety Meeting
 - a. These engineers and conductors need to have this information passed to them before they assume their duties on the train. Contact the Station Master or, in his absence, the VP Operations.
 - b. We believe this is essential to the safe operation of the trains.
2. Relief Engineers and Conductors
 - a. Communication with the engineer and/or conductor being relieved is required with the relief crew to know how the train is operating and any current track conditions.
 - b. We all know that all trains operate do not the same, nor does any particular train operate the same from day to day and sometimes during the same day.
